Zoe Antoniades also conducted three writing workshops with our Year 2 children focusing on creating their own 'Cally and Jimmy' story. Zoe Antoniades inspired some of our children who did not like writing, to write; it was the next day these children came into school with stories written by themselves at home about 'Cally and Jimmy!' They were so excited to show their teachers. Due to Zoe Antoniades' visit, many pupils in Year 3 began to read again after purchasing her books. One parent informed me how 'She found her daughter one night under her covers reading the 'Cally and Jimmy' books by torch light when she should have been asleep!'

Zoe Antoniades is coming to visit our school again in March 2024 to help us celebrate World Book Day. I am so looking forward to telling the children as I know they will be very excited. She is a fantastic author who helped us transfer the love and importance of reading to some children who would never even pick up a book!

Our Visit from Zoe Antoniades

On Wednesday 10th May, an author called Zoe Antoniades came to tell us all about her books. The whole of Year 4 went up to the library and listened to her talk. Year 5 and 6 also had a talk with Ms Antoniades during the morning.

Zoe has written a collection of short stories: The *Invincible Voices* series. The stories are unique because they are actually written by children, but in collaboration with her. She runs writing clubs, and one of the boys in Year 6, Adam Hakiem, goes to the

club, and has stories featured in the books!

Zoe helped us to understand



the structure of a story, and the importance of planning it sensibly. She introduced us to the idea of a Story Mountain (which Ms Lawrence often tells us about), and Aristotle's Story Arc (which was new to us).

We learnt a lot from this session, and enjoyed hearing a story from one of the books. Zoe left us a few of her books and they are currently the most popular books in both Year 4 and 5.
