

**Zoe Antoniadis** is the author of *Cally & Jimmy*, a series books for children about London-based siblings of Greek Cypriot heritage. Cally has a twin brother Jimmy, and he is always getting into some kind of mischief - which usually means double trouble. Thankfully their Yiayia is on hand to help - or add to the mayhem!

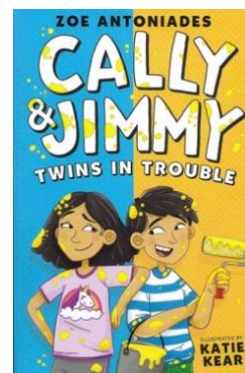


There are four hilarious stories in each book and they appeal to all primary school children, especially those aged 6-10 years. In the first book, *Twins in Trouble*, they get into scrapes together, bake some 'unusual' cakes, almost ruin their school assembly and finally have a twintabulous tenth birthday party. The second book, *Twintastic*, sees the twins make a splash on their beach holiday in Cyprus, run into trouble on sports day, get spooked while trick or treating, and uncover a thief at school. There is plenty more pandemonium in the third book, *Twins Together*, as they look after the school hamster for half term, have a competition to build the best snowman, raise money with a yard sale, and have a rollercoaster of a time at the local theme park. In the fourth book, *Twins separable*, can Cally and Jimmy, be trusted to walk home alone? Will there be mayhem at the movies? And what could possibly go wrong when they go to work at Dad's office or camp out in the forest on a school residential trip? Plus, there's a new girl at school who's not quite as perfect as she might at first seem...

Zoe's own Cypriot roots have found their way into the stories of Cally & Jimmy (Calista and Dimitri) not only through the traditions and superstitions of Yiayia but also via all sorts of cross-cultural experiences and escapades. In the second book, *Twintastic*, they go on holiday to Cyprus and stay in Deftera, just outside Nicosia, where Zoe's mother, Koula Louki is from. Her father Emiliios Antoniadis is from Pedoulas (Troodos). Both Zoe's parents moved to England in the late 1950s and the books also show how second and third generation Cypriots live amongst a culturally and richly diverse West London community today.

*Cally & Jimmy* are a *Book Trust Pick* and have been described by their reviewers as 'an entertaining collection... full of humour and heart'. *Twins in Trouble* was also Love Reading's *Book of the Month* and also appears on their recommended lists celebrating both disability and diversity. Jimmy himself is a neurodivergent character as he has ADHD. His challenges and the way in which he rises above them are championed as well as his many strengths and talents. *Twins in Trouble*, was longlisted for the Alligator's Mouth Award 2022, and achieved third prize in the *Our Best Book Award* initiative run by Leicester Libraries, Schools and Council which promotes books which 'motivate children to read for pleasure' selecting books that 'appeal and [are] accessible to as many readers as possible.'

Zoe grew up and went to school in Twickenham and Chiswick and currently lives in Isleworth in the London Borough of Hounslow. She graduated from the University of Hull with a degree in English and Drama and later trained as a teacher at the Institute of Education. She often writes collaboratively with young people and has published four anthologies of short stories: *Invincible Voices - Long Shorts, Medium Shorts, Short Shorts* and *Winter Shorts*. She has also written a memoir, *Tea and Baklavas*, which won the Winchester Writers' Festival Memoir Prize.



Now signed with Andersen Press, she has written the series about twins, *Cally & Jimmy*. There are four books in the series so far: *Twins in Trouble, Twintastic, Twins Together* and *Twinseparable*.



Zoe gives lots of author talks online and loves visiting schools and appearing at libraries, bookshops, festivals and events nationwide and even in Cyprus.

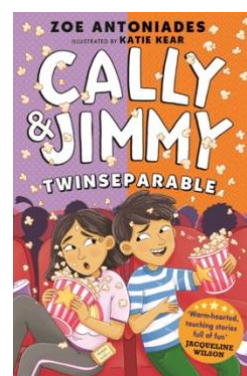
